Accessibility Statement

Webshop Logisztika Kft. is committed to making its website accessible in accordance with the requirements of Act XVII of 2022 on accessibility for products and services.

This accessibility statement applies to the Desirel website.

1. Standards and Guidelines

The accessibility of our webshop is based on the MSZ EN 301 549 standard, in line with applicable legislation. This standard follows the international WCAG 2.1 (Web Content Accessibility Guidelines).

During development, we follow the four main accessibility principles (POUR):

- **Perceivable:** Information and user interface elements are accessible to all users (e.g. text alternatives for images).
- **Operable:** The interface and navigation can be used by everyone (e.g. full keyboard control).
- **Understandable:** Content and operation are clear and easy to understand (e.g. clear error messages during checkout).
- **Robust:** Content works reliably with assistive technologies (e.g. screen readers).

2. Compliance Status

Based on an accessibility audit, our webshop is **partially compliant** with the MSZ EN 301 549 standard (WCAG 2.1 AA level).

Non-accessible content:

Some elements provided by third-party services may not fully meet accessibility requirements.

- Trustindex review module

Disproportionate burden:

Due to language differences and grammatical structures, it is currently not possible to provide fully accurate accessibility texts for all dynamically generated buttons across more than 26 languages.
